

Activities of the Office of Technical Inspection

The Office of Technical Inspection (in Polish: *Urząd Dozoru Technicznego*, or UDT) operates throughout Poland to ensure the safe use of technical equipment. We check its condition, perform tests and help to solve technical problems.

Who are we?

- We have over 100 years of tradition and operate nationwide.
- We employ around 1,400 engineers.
- We have 10 branches and 20 offices.
- We have laboratories that perform tests both at our permanent premises and on-site at our customers' premises, as well as a laboratory that calibrates measuring equipment.

What do we do?

Our main tasks:

- We oversee more than 1.7 million devices and perform over a million tests a year.
- We inspect pressure equipment (e.g., boilers, pipelines) and material-handling equipment (e.g., hoists, cranes).
- We ensure public safety in areas involving technical equipment.

Our roles?

- We verify whether devices meet the requirements – UDT is Notified Body No. 1433.
- UDT-CERT is a certification body: we certify management systems, individuals and products.

- We conduct tests in laboratories, prepare expert reports and calibrate measuring equipment.
- We organise training courses – we train manufacturers and users of equipment.
- We certify RES installers – we inspect training centres.
- We certify companies and staff working with F-gases.
- We inspect electric car chargers.
- We supervise equipment in the nuclear power sector.
- We recognise professional qualifications from other EU countries.
